

# How to Reserve a *WOMBAT* Fiberglass Rebody Kit

## To Place a Reservation

Please fill out the reservation form, sign it, and mail or fax it to us. When we receive your deposit we will confirm receipt, send your Wombat Assembly Manual and give you an estimated ship date.

You need to pay \$250 down to secure the price and a place in the production line. The balance is due, including any crating or shipping costs, before the kit leaves our facility.

We accept personal checks, cashier's checks, money orders, and electronic transfers. A personal check will not secure your place in the production line until it has cleared. **Manual Credit:** If you have already purchased a manual please add a note to the form and remit a \$225 reservation fee (deducting the \$25 manual cost from the \$250 fee).

**Mount Clamp & Epoxy Gun Deposits:** The Wombat floorboards bond to the center tunnel with a 2-part epoxy. We provide a Simpson Brand Epoxy Tie Tool Model # EDT22A and two custom mount clamps for this step. There is a refundable \$100 deposit on the gun and a \$150 deposit on the mount clamps. The deposits will be returned to you when you return the clamps and epoxy gun.

## Shipping

We ship via common carrier. We load the kit into an empty trailer and erect a bulkhead to protect it from possible damage by subsequent loads. Casters will be bolted to the front of the body so that the body may be moved like a wheelbarrow. Bumpers, small parts boxes, etc. will be strapped to the body.

Shipping costs range from about \$800 to \$2000, depending on your location. We need a delivery address, including zip code, to get a shipping quote from our shipping broker. We also need to know if the address is a business or residential address.

Some items may be shipped separately from the body via UPS. Please let us know what address you would like us to use for UPS shipments.

You are welcome to arrange your own shipping if you prefer. You may also make arrangements to come to Washington State and pick up your kit at the fiberglass manufacturer. Customers have carried bodies home on flat bed trailers, across the beds of pickup trucks, and mounted on chassis and towed. If you bring your chassis, we can bond your body for you.
